MEMORANDUM FOR AFROTC DET 025 ALL

SUBJECT: Field Training Preparation (FTP) cadet training

References: (a) AFROTCI 36-2011, *Cadet Operations*

1. This memorandum summarizes HQ/AFROTC guidance regarding FTP cadet training. FTP training may include implementing unique military decorum rules from Holm Center T-203 (*AFROTC Field Training Manual*), but only during LLAB hours. Cadets will not conduct activities/exercises with the intention of simulating the stresses of the FT environment/experience. Prohibited activities include, but are not limited to:

- a. Giving direct individual feedback with raised voices.
- b. Using a merit/demerit system. AFROTC Form 341 may be used as a visual aid for instructional purposes only.
- c. Any cadets acting as Cadet Training Assistants (CTA) or officers acting as Flight Training Officers (FTO).
- d. Physical Discipline activities of any kind.
- e. Using FT Group Leadership Problems (GLP). Use only Holm Center/CR-approved GLPs.
- f. Actions that have traditionally been part of "mini-camps" including but not limited to sleep deprivation, uniform "superman" (quickly changing uniforms) drills, performing time compressed activities (e.g. eating), etc.

2. Any FTP activities conducted outside of LLAB hours is considered voluntary Practical Military Training (PMT). Voluntary PMT for the sole purpose of conducting FTP activities will have commander or DO supervision. FTP activities will not violate the Holm Center Training Manual, AFROTCI 36-2011, or other applicable instructions

3. Any questions regarding the guidance provide should be directed to the Operations Flight Commander.
